- Document repository: Adding taxonomy, description of documents
- Search functionality: Very confusing
- Version control of documents: Not easy to manage
- Internal pages and linking together: No option to create pages
- Information storage: No option to do information listing other than spreadsheets

- Suited for small or medium sized organization because of easy setup and cost
- Helps get teams come together and work together, but not a Digital Workplace solution
- Not good for content management
- Not a good solution for managing work from a long-term perspective.
